

Portland Heights Birdwatching Breaks  
Friday January 22nd – Sunday January 24<sup>th</sup> 2010

**Saturday January 23rd**

**Weather: Overcast and cold in the morning, sunny intervals in the afternoon. Cold easterly breeze.**

Portland Bill, 0900

We started the weekend with a splendid hour or two looking at the huge numbers of seabirds feeding off the Bill. Most were Guillemots but we also saw large numbers of Kittiwakes and Gannets along with a few Razorbills and Fulmars. Gulls were much in evidence with 6 species seen altogether including several Mediterranean Gulls. The highlight was when a flock of 8 Purple Sandpipers flew out from the rocks below us.

The fields near the Bird Observatory produced a couple Buzzards as well as flocks of Skylarks and Linnets along with a flock of 16 Stock Doves.

Grove Point, 1100

The cliffs at Grove Point were home to plenty of Fulmars, the resident pair of Ravens and, best of all, the male Peregrines. The Royal Navy were very busy as well with several ships to see including the new stealth destroyer HMS Daring as well as the assault ship HMS Albion with its Chinook helicopter and attendant SBS landing craft.



Portland Castle, 1200

Our first look at Portland Harbour produced a few Red-breasted Mergansers, a Razorbill and some Turnstones.

Ferrybridge, 1300

A handful of Dark-bellied Brent Geese and 33 Mediterranean Gulls accompanied us as we ate our sandwiches.

Butterstreet Cove, 1400

Once we had forded the rapids we were presented with an enormous variety of wildfowl including hundreds of Brent Geese, 4 of which were of the Pale-bellied race. A couple of drake Goldeneye were found on the far side of the Fleet.

Lodmoor, 1500

Here we added Ruddy Duck, Lapwing and Black-tailed Godwit to the day's list with a number of other water birds as well.

### **Sunday January 25<sup>th</sup>**

**Weather: Calm with long sunny intervals throughout. Excellent visibility.**

Heights Hotel, 0800

Today we started finding birds even before we left the hotel with some brilliant views of Ravens from our breakfast table! We also saw the only Song Thrush of the weekend in this way.

Portland Bill, 0900

A second visit to the Bill made sure we added Common Scoter to the list but far more remarkable was the sight of no less than 6 Ravens flying over us, calling loudly. The sea was still covered with thousands of Razorbills, Guillemots and Kittiwakes and we were pleased to find 3 Purple Sandpipers on the shoreline.

Wyke Regis, 1030

From this vantage point over Portland Harbour we managed to find a record total of 12 Black-necked Grebes. Several Great Northern Divers were also found but all were very distant.

Bincleaves, 1200

The far north-western corner of the harbour produced a close Slavonian Grebe and some more distant divers.

Newton's Cove, 1300

Our lunch was had here sitting in gorgeous warm sunshine looking at an impossibly blue sea. When we could stand the questions from the dozens of passers-by no more we walked along the sea wall and eventually found a male Black Redstart, but sadly there were too many people around to allow it to settle anywhere that we could see it.



Radipole RSPB Reserve, 1430

A host of wildfowl here all in immaculate breeding plumage, including our old favourite *Hoodie*, the Hooded Merganser. A Marsh Harrier turned up as we walked back and was closely followed by the only Sparrowhawk of the weekend.

To round everything off nicely we went back to the hotel for a cream tea and one of the most colourful sunsets I have seen in a long time.
